WART is currently seeking qualified candidates for the position of Medical Logistician.

PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The medical Logistician will ensure that our deployed medical teams have the medical equipment, devices and consumables they need to ensure the best possible health outcomes.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide monthly reports on procurement, inventory, facility and fleet management to the Lot Coordinator and provide a quarterly report and analysis to Project coordinator.
- Ensure that all stocks are registered and tracked from receipt to distribution, with live reports available on stock balances and stock movements through the organizational inventory management system
- Ensure that all stocks are stored appropriately to ensure no theft and no damage or loss from pests and water/ heat damage.
- Ensure that all medical supplies are stored appropriately, including pest control and cold chain requirements

 Conduct regular spot checks using standard organization tools to verify stocks and demonstrate effective stock management with 'Stock Count Accuracy analysis.

- Source cost effective and quality freight options, that are suitable for medical supplies where required, for the movement of stock between locations and to distribution sites.
- Conduct assessments of government health facilities, including any structural improvement recommendations for the ministry of health to action) to support inventory management improvements, supporting process and tools reviews and trainings as required
- Supervise the pharmaceutical stores at the CHDs and monitor adherence to specified pharmacy management and storage guidelines.
- · Ensure that drug registers are available in all supported health facilities
- Ensure the last mile distribution of drugs to supported health facilities and the BHWs within required timeline
- Collect data on drug consumption and movement in the supported health facilities and prepares timely
 monthly and other ad hoc reports on pharmaceutical drugs and supplies.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date record of medicine and supplies in the main store and dispensary
- Receive new medicine and supplies, document, label and neatly arrange them in the main store and notify the dispensary on the new stock.
- Ensure coordination between the health facilities for drug rotation purposes to ensure that stock-out of drugs is minimized in the health facilities and for BHWs.
- Provide on job training to dispensers in health facilities and on tidiness and how to update stock card pharmaceutical record keeping.
- Ensure medical inventory tracking is up to date and produce weekly, monthly and quarterly reports.
- Any other responsibilities assigned by the supervisor.

- · Relevant degree in Pharmacy and or medical logistic management
- Demonstrated Experience with inventory managing of medical supplies, including good storage and good distribution practices
- Minimum of 4 years of experience in operations or logistics, preferably with related field.
- Demonstrated experience in procurement of various types of goods/services (experience with international procurement an asset) and donor procurement requirements
