Under the supervision of Infrastructure Program Manager, provides expert technical leadership, policy, and engineering program guidance to the EPRR activity in South Sudan. Provides technical support to engineering plans, design, and oversees execution of analysis and research. Support the Chief Engineer / Team Leader / Infrastructure Program Manager and FHI 360 management on the development of policy/programming options, and recommends appropriate choices, on the basis of a comprehensive analysis of infrastructure engineering and construction development problems, alternative actions, objectives, and consistency with overall domestic and international policy and law. Provides technical leadership to a civil engineering program of national scope and impact.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Development, implementation and maintenance of programmatic structures for the successful execution of architectural / engineering (A/E) projects, construction management, and construction acquisitions, including participation on contract review boards.
- Contracting for A-E, construction management, and construction services (e.g., design and bid documents for performance-based and incentives contracts, design-build and design-bid-build contracts, construction oversight and management services, etc.).
- Direction and oversight of operations and maintenance, strategic planning, resource allocation, production methods and the coordination of people and resources.
- Provision of leadership in the acquisition of A/E services to regional and/or national staff by assessing proposed project delivery strategies by more junior professionals.
- Review and evaluation of the adequacy of specific project documentation such as project management plans, cost estimates, acquisition plans, and contracts prepared by support staff.
- Evaluation of the performance of professional staff with respect to A/E acquisitions.
- Inspection of project sites to monitor progress and ensure conformance to design specifications and safety and sanitation standards.
- Direction of construction, operations and maintenance activities at project sites.
- Estimating quantities and cost of materials, equipment or labor to determine project feasibility.
- Preparation and presentation of public reports, such as bid proposals, deeds, environmental impact statements, and property and right of way descriptions.
- Perform other duties as may be assigned.

**Requirements:** A B.S. degree in civil engineering or architecture from an accredited college or university • A Master's degree from an accredited college or university in a field of study related to engineering, international development or a related field, such as international relations, foreign affairs, economics, business administration, public policy, or other relevant field • 7-9 years of significant professional engineering experience in the public and private sectors, applying advanced principles and practices of the field, enabling the engineer to investigate and provide consultative services on
