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Overview of the Project:

The overall objective of the Alight South Sudan Program is to assist the South Sudanese to respond and react to community needs. To achieve this objective, Alight implements a multi-sectoral program that includes Water and Sanitation, Nutrition, Gender based violence prevention and response, Shelter and CCCM activities. Alight's is expanding its outreach mechanisms and introducing innovative new initiatives. Alight currently has program activities in Aweil West, Ulang, Morobo and Kajo-Keji Counties.

Primary Purpose of The Position

Based in Kajo Keji, you are a member of our Logistics & Supply Chain team. Under the supervision of the Logistics & Supply Chain Manager, the Field Logistics & Supply Chain Assistant is responsible for

Major Areas of Responsibilities:

The Field Logistics & Supply Chain Assistant is responsible for overseeing the following.

- In charge of all procurement processes, sourcing, negotiating with vendors, supplier selection and management, maintaining a supplier database, issuing of purchase orders and contracts, reporting, ensuring compliance with Alight logistics and procurement policies and donor requirements and generate monthly procurement reports on time.
- Warehousing management stock and inventory control and generating monthly warehouse reports on time.
- Fleet coordinate and handle vehicle requests from other staff for intown travel and various field destinations. Maintain a logbook of vehicle movement, mileage, servicing, petrol consumption and general vehicle condition. Perform vehicle daily checks and schedule vehicle servicing and repairs. Ensure vehicles are kept clean and inside and outside, always and that the organization stickers are always visible. Handle annual vehicle inspection and insurance renewal for each vehicle and motorcycles and handle insurance cases of any incidents. Generating monthly fleet reports on time.
- Assets Ensure all assets are recorded, perform physical checks, and generate monthly assets report.
- IT help users troubleshoot technical issues, configure printers and emails for new users.
 Troubleshoot and resolve outlook, network and internet issues and escalate where necessary. On time preparation of IT reports
- Transportation assist in organizing transportation of staff and supplies to the field sites.
 Prepare documentation for staff movement in and out of Aweil. On time preparation of transport reports
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.



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You will ensure that all program activities requiring the support of supply chain units are implemented in a timely manner.

- Provide leadership for management of administrative & operational activities.
- Effectively manage Alight South Sudan assets, facilities, and administrative and logistical services.

- At least 2 years' experience with NGOs or other development/aid agencies in supply chain management in officer level.
- Able to work well in a team and to undertake assigned tasks independently.
- Ability to work productively, impartially, and respectfully in a multi-cultural environment.
- Willingness and ability to work in insecure environment and adhere to ALIGHT security policies.
- Fluent in Spoken, Reading, and Written English.
