About us:

HealthNet TPO strives for developing evidence-based interventions to strengthen the health of populations in distress.

With Funding from HPF, HealthNet TPO in Consortium with Impact Health organisation (IHO) and in Collaboration with the CHD of the Raja County, supports Essential Health Care services provision in Raja County Hospital and across health facilities and in the communities within Raja County.

The purpose of the Job:

The Nurse Anaesthetist will be part of HealthNet TPO's South Sudan team and he /she will coordinate all surgical and theatre activities in Raja hospital under the supervision and guidance of the hospital Obstetrician/Gynecologist. He/she will be responsible for provision of surgical, anaesthetic and infection prevention and control services within Raja Hospital while working together with other key personnel in the Hospital. He/she will surgical patients, supervise the staffs and ensure capacity building of staffs and adherence to correct theatre management and treatment protocols that improve quality of surgical services in Raja hospital..

Main Responsibilities:

- Manage all the infection prevention and control measures in the theatre by ensuring that the theatre is cleaned always, major theatre scrubbing done at least once every week, instruments and theatre linen are clean, dried, packed in sets, sterilized and stored properly for operation and after the operation.
- Responsible for administering all anesthetic drugs during surgery, and the preparation of equipment for monitoring the patient's condition
- Contribute to development of Theatre specific SOPs
- Liaise with the hospital coordinator to ensure that theatre list is provided in time and appropriate sets made available on operation day
- Manage the stock of the theatre pharmaceuticals/supplies and ensures that routine drugs/medicines/consumable are requested in time for theatre use,
- Prepares monthly consumption and inventories for theatre and other departments.



- Clerks or support clerkship of all elective surgical patients and ensuring that they are well prepared for the surgical procedure including consent and administration of preoperative treatment before surgery.
- Perform or assist in aseptic and safe anesthesia, close monitoring of all pre, intra and post-operative cases, and completing of all the required documentation throughout the process of surgical patient care.
- Participate in bereavement counseling in an event of death on table
- Ensure dressing of OPD, Maternity, and Surgical are done as instructed by the doctors.
- Responsible for weekly and monthly theatre indicators submission to HMIS Officer
- Attend all, and make presentations on scheduled continuous medical education session on relevant theatre topics.eg Infection prevention, patient safety in theatre, obtaining informed consent etc
- Initiate weekly theatre meetings with typed minutes submitted to the Hospital coordinator for filling
- Attend and contribute in the weekly management committee meetings of head of departments.
- Attend all general staff meetings as organized by hospital management
- Conduct on job daily training of theatre nurse assistants and other staffs whenever necessary
- Assist the Senior Midwife delegation duties in his/her leaves.
- Undertake any other duties that may be assigned by your immediate supervisor.



PERSON SPECIFICATION

- Qualified Diploma nurse with a diploma or certificate in Anesthesia from a recognized institution. A certificate nurse with a training on anesthesia and substantial experience may be accepted.
- At least 2-5 years working experience in theatre that has active surgical services.
- Good Command of English, Arabic speaking skills and added advantage to the native language.
- Knowledge on use of computer software packages such as word, excel and DHIS.
- A good understanding and experience of working with County Health Officials, State Ministry Officials, Donors and UN agencies and the health system in South Sudan Experience.

You have/ are:

- Flexible and organized in a challenging environment, previous experience of working in locations with basic and limited resources.
- Team player, able to listen and motivate, Excellent planning, supervisory and advisory skills
- Proven training and health education skills, proven ability to teach/pass knowledge to staff
- Excellent organizational development skills with attention to detail
- Able to work in a culturally diverse environment with remote teams, under minimal supervision
- Able to work under pressure, occasional flexibility in terms of working off hours
- Ability to work with teams remotely and with high sensitivity to cultural and social diversity
