Sudan Evangelical Mission (SEM) is a National Non-Governmental Organization operating in Western Equatoria State and Western Bahr el Ghazal State in the Republic of South Sudan. SEM is registered with the Ministry of Justice as a national NGO and with the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) in South Sudan. SEM runs programs in Protection, Food Security and livelihoods, Disability Inclusion, and Adult Literacy integrated with Peacebuilding.

Specific responsibilities

- Conducting examinations, creating individualized care plans, and providing care for patients diagnosed with eye conditions.
- Document all care rendered, treatment, and response to treatment in the Eye Care Unit records.
- Monitor the progress of patients with eye conditions and the side effects of treatment.
- Offering health education and support to patients' families regarding treatment expectations.
- Liaise with other healthcare staff and specialist clinics to handle patients with multiple or complex medical conditions and initiate referrals to nearby facilities and Buluk Eye Clinic in Juba.

• Ensure the smooth running of activities under outreach and at the Mundri Leaun Centre's Experimental Care Unit.

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- Participate in planning, organizing, and supporting eye surgeries with visiting surgeons at Mundri Health Centre's Eye Care Unit.
- Supervise, guide, and mentor the ophthalmic nursing team and other multi-disciplinary team members.
- Conduct community nonsurgical outreaches.
- Prepare and submit detailed work plans and monthly reports on all the activities conducted by the eye care team to the Disability Program Coordinator.
- Participate in planning, designing, and budgeting of eye care projects.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized institution.
- Higher Diploma in Ophthalmology Specialization from a recognized institution.
- At least five years working experience as an Ophthalmology Clinical Officer in a reputable health facility.
- Proficiency in computer applications: word processor (Word), a spreadsheet program (Excel), a
 presentation program (PowerPoint).
