Overall Responsibility:

To organize, implement Water Supply, hygiene Promotion and Sanitation activities under WASH in Schools UNICEF funded Project through the implementation of Three Star Approach mostly of the hardware components.

Tasks and duties:

- ✓ Provide advice and support on technical WASH Components
- ✓ Develop and ensure the use of appropriate design, construction/ rehabilitations, BoQs and implementation of WASH hardware according to technical standard as well as proper maintenance and use of WASH equipment.
- ✓ Design and supervision of boreholes and water yard drilling, construction, and rehabilitation.
- ✓ To conduct training for Water Management Committees and community Based hand-pump mechanics and supervision of water management committees work, in coordination with the relevant State Water authority
- ✓ Regular monitoring of water sources and water quality testing in the schools and the surrounding communities.
- ✓ Track the progress of activities, ensure the collecting of program indicators, and provide on-time monthly reports.
- ✓ Identify and monitor risks, constraints, or escalating issues, and provide guidance in addressing them.
