Background

The **MEAL Officer** will work under direct supervision of the Programme Coordinator. In the framework of a project entitled "Integrated Education and Protection (GBV & CP) Response for People Affected by Conflict and Flood in Ezo and Leer (Envelope 2 & 3)", the MEAL Officer will provide crucial operational and technical support for all MEAL related activities to the project and other ongoing projects.

Core Responsibilities

INTERSOS South Sudan MEAL system development;

- Support in the development of INTERSOS South Sudan MEAL systems in compliance with INTERSOS's MEAL Policies and Procedures, project management standards and donors' MEAL and reporting requirements and their roll out to the field staff;
- Set up simple systems to manage information generated by MEAL activities (databases, beneficiary lists, etc.);
- Support on the standardization of MEAL function and processes in the overall programme management cycle
 of South Sudan mission.

MEAL planning

- Develop and continuously update INTERSOS MEAL plan for all on-going projects to ensure all MEAL related documents and tools are acquired, organized, up-to-date and accessible;
- Work with Program staff in developing of a general MEAL checklist for all thematic areas of INTERSOS programs;
- Contribute to the development of location-based data analysis and generate location-based humanitarian and development nexus strategies.

MEAL implementation;

- Collaborate with program staff on the implementation of all project MEAL plans including data collection, data cleaning, data analysis, learning mechanisms and data management;
- Coordinate and manage Baseline Surveys, Needs Assessments, Perception survey, KAP Surveys, Post
 Distribution Monitoring (PDM), End Line surveys etc in coordination with Programme Coordinator and Project
 Managers;
- Support planning, implementation and follow-up of both internal and external monitoring and evaluations, including preparing ToRs, literature review packs, recruiting evaluators, planning evaluator itineraries, planning staff workshops, leading report review.

- University (Bachelor's & preferably Master) degree in the field to Statistics, Social sciences, international development, Political sciences or related field;
- Minimum of 5 years of work experience working with NGO on project management related roles among which 2 years of experience should be on MEAL responsibilities;

- Proficiency in database development/management, and skills in analyzing, interpreting and communicating data;
