Position Summary:

RI is looking for an experienced Nutrition Program Technical Lead to provide technical oversight for program interventions across six counties in Upper Nile, South Sudan. The role holder will lead Nutrition Strategy roll out, ensuring program design, integration, implementation, monitoring, preparedness, coordination, reporting, quality assurance and people management are in sync with RI program quality standards, donor regulations and sector best practices. The role holder will also provide technical support to overall program planning, proposal writing, budget management, research and annual reporting.

Job Responsibilities and Duties:

Program Management

Provide hands-on field support, guidance and technical oversight for the implementation of nutrition interventions
throughout the project cycle to ensure project design, start-up, implementation and close-out are in line with quality
principles and standards, donor guidelines, and sector best practices.

Work closely with internal stakeholders, local authorities and communities to ensure integrated planning and implementation that is complementary and collaborative.

Ensure that beneficiaries are effectively targeted according to established vulnerability criteria.

- Experience leading the development and implementation of evidence-based, multi-sectoral nutrition and social & behavioral change program intended to improve nutrition, and food security
