Job purpose

The Nurse Anesthetist has the main responsibilities of administering anesthesia and monitoring patients through their surgeries. He/she will prepare and administer the patient specific amount of anesthesia needed for the procedure, and will maintain the patient's anesthesia levels during surgery.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Administers anesthetics to patients undergoing medical and surgical procedures.
- Obtains supplies and equipment ready for procedures
- Performs and documents a pre-anesthetic assessment and evaluation of the patient, including selecting, ordering and administering pre anesthetic drugs
- Selects, obtains or administers the anesthetics, adjuvant drugs, accessory drugs, and fluids necessary to manage the anesthetic, to maintain the patient's physiologic homeostasis, and to correct abnormal responses to the anesthesia or surgery.
- Selects and initiates the planned anesthetic technique which may include: general regional and local anesthesia and intravenous sedation/monitored anesthesia care (MAC).
- Manage anesthesiological services and coordinate with other professionals to formulate procedures and plans; direct the duties of medical technicians, nurses and other healthcare support staff
- Educate patients and families on post-procedure care and possible complications; instruct on different ways to prevent disease and improve health
- Provides routine ward round and care
- Develops and implements an anesthetic plan

Qualifications

- Diploma in Nursing or Clinical medicine
- Minimum 3 years of experience in anesthesiology
- Must have recent clinical experience in patient care for at least six months out of the past year.
- Certification in Advanced Cardiac Life Support {ACLS} desirable.
- Commitment to CCM's work and values.
- Fluency in written and spoken English knowledge of Taposa Language and Arabic is an asset.
