## Job Advertisement Midwife

**Location: Renk (This is a Local Position, the successful candidate will be responsible for flight, feeding and accommodation)**

**Job Purpose:** To provide wholistic midwifery care to women and newborns during the antenatal, <sup>Assistant</sup>intrapartum and postnatal period. This includes outpatient and inpatient care. Care may be provided at the Abayok health facility or any other Medair site in Renk County.

### Key Responsibilities

#### Medical / Technical (60%)

- Provide comprehensive ANC according to MoH/WHO guidelines, encouraging women to attend for 8 ANC visits
- Perform and document accurate and timely assessments of women presenting for routine ANC or emergency presentations
- Screen all women for malnutrition and refer to Medair nutrition programme as appropriate
- Lead care for all women in second stage of labour, ensuring skilled birth attendant present at delivery
- Manage the first stages of response to obstetric emergencies – including PPH, sepsis, delay in labour, APH, retained placenta – informing midwife supervisor/reproductive health manager
- Perform other duties as necessary to fulfil the role

#### Quality management (10%)

- Participate as requested in Medair internal workshops and teaching sessions to keep up with changing trends, new guidelines and best practices
- Undertake other activities required to contribute to clinical quality improvement, as identified by Medair

#### Documentation and Reporting (10%)

- Interpret and act on documented findings, escalating to midwife supervisor/reproductive health manager as necessary
- Contribute to documentation used to collect data for the provision of quality and timely reports. This includes weekly and monthly data reports

#### Communication and Coordination (10%)

- Lead and participate in handover of inpatients at each shift change
- Accompany women when transferred for hospital for management of emergencies, providing comprehensive handover
- Maintain appropriate, regular, transparent and supportive communication with the Medair team and beneficiaries.

#### Logistics and pharmacy (10%)

- Regularly monitor and report low stock levels of medicines or damaged equipment to Midwife Supervisor.
- Prepared to take on delegated midwife supervisor responsibilities, where required, when midwife supervisor on leave

- Clinical Degree or Diploma in Midwifery
- 2 years post-qualification midwifery experience
- Experience working in ANC, PNC and labour wards
- Fluent in English both written and spoken
- **Fluent in spoken Arabic**

- 1 year working with similar organization (NGO, humanitarian response organization)
- Fluent in written
- Ability to speak, or willingness to learn, local language
