Purpose of the position:

The core responsibilities of this position are to take the lead in overall project management, implementation and coordination of the project (Protection and solutions response to displaced populations and returnees in Warrap and Northern Bahr el Ghazal States, South Sudan).

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Lead the proper planning, implementation, monitoring, and reporting of the project activities in its operational area. Prepare work plan, DIP, Cash flow, procurement plan for the project
- Prepare and submit quality project report as per the report requirement of the project as well as build and maintain effective relationships with UNHCR, Protection partners, government officials, and community and WV internal staff.
- Monthly management of project expenditure, including monitoring of monthly Financial Reports, and overall budget management. Review on monthly expenditure to ensure accuracy and audit compliance, in collaboration with Finance Officer
- Ensure gender equity and sensitivity in beneficiary selection and planning and execution of activities.
- People Management – Management of project staff to ensure timely completion of activities
- Prepare and submit weekly / monthly project updates to Zonal Program Manager, based on data collected by project staff.



Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- A degree in social work and related discipline preferred, Experience in community engagement and provision of training on PSS required (UNICEF PSS models from CPiE preferred)
- Minimum 3-4 years with similar experience as project Officer or 2 years as project coordinator in Social Work. Experience of working in Warrap is an added advantage
- Familiarity with child rights, Child Protection in Emergency Minimum Standards, GBV basic principles, human rights, principles of confidentiality and consent, referral practices for child protection and/or GBV response services.
- Knowledge and experience from among the following skill sets is desirable:
- Should be highly skilled in writing programmatic reports
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Oral and written Arabic will be added advantage.
- Having demonstrated organizational, interpersonal and communication skills; organized, efficient, and able to meet deadlines
- Proficiency in using computer software e. g MS Windows, MS office programs and internet.
- Ability to work under pressure in unstable security and remote environment is an asset;
