## SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

The Samaritan's Purse (SP) WASH Program is currently carrying out humanitarian relief activities to reduce the incidence of water borne and hygiene related diseases among the most vulnerable populations in Mankien. The Drilling Coordinator's main responsibilities will be planning, organizing and managing resources of the overall drilling operation, water quality test, pump installation and borehole sitting. The coordinator will also be responsible in coordinating and leading community mobilization in line with the drilling activities, and submitting regular reports on the work being completed.
