SUMMARY

The Community Development Facilitator (CDF) will work with refugee and host communities in South Sudan, to facilitate strengths-based community-led, community-based and community-owned processes that support social cohesion and self-reliant community governance structures.

Aligned with the complex nature of the local development context, the facilitator will use an adaptive approach, working with groups and key stakeholders to support local processes toward self-management and sustainable local governance capacities to transfer the refugee population in a select location into an integrated permanent self-governed community.

As part of the adaptive management approach, the CDF will engage in continuous monitoring and evaluation as basis for making adjustments to the implementation, and to capture lessons learned for the learning/research component of this project.

ESSENCIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Using a community entry process to establish and build positive working relationships with community groups, leaders, key stakeholders and government entities.
- Using local informants as local experts, engage in an ongoing process of learning about the peoples, cultures and communities.
- Engage groups and leaders in strengths-based self-reflection and visioning processes for community, social cohesion and increased self-governance.
- Assist groups, churches and communities to develop their own goals and action plans toward social cohesion and self-governance, and support the implementation of the action plans.
- 5. Using an action-reflection cycle, assist groups, churches and communities with the evaluations of their own work, and capture tessons learned to inform subsequent project cycles.
- 6. Work with the project researchers to facilitate the research process, provide data and engage in active ongoing research to capture learnings about this adaptive community development process.
- Maintain timely and accurate budget controls and provide necessary reporting to Country Director and IHQ as per SP policy.

8. Other relevant duties as assigned by the Area Coordinator and Country Senior Management Team.

The CDF will directly supervise two Community Development Coordinators and, at times, will oversee various technical support staff consultants and coordinate with associated program units.

- o Desire to empower the local Church to be Jesus' healing power in their communities.

Degree in a Humanities or Social Science discipline (e.g. Social Work, Social Anthropology) and/or proven competence in qualifications listed.

Written and verbal English. Ability to provide data and basic reports and business correspondence. Knowledge of Sudanese Arabic, or willingness to learn.
