JOB VACANCY: FSL Project Officer (1)

AVSI Foundation is a global non-governmental organization with headquarters in Italy. Its mission is to support human development in developing countries according to the social teaching of the Catholic Church: recognizing the uniqueness of each person, who as such cannot be reduced to a number within an anonymous category such as "the poor, the sick, the disabled". Furthermore, every person and every community represent a resource, regardless of their vulnerability. This is why AVSI works to help people in becoming aware of their own value and dignity. AVSI is operating in South Sudan since 2005, implementing medium to long-term sustainable health, education, water & sanitation, food security and emergency relief programmes.

Purpose of the position

The FSL Project Officer shall be assisting the implementation of the FSL emergency response livelihood project funded by FAO in Juba County. He/She shall provide technical support required to the team through supervision, management and reporting of the project progress. Liaise with the FSL project Manager for any field activity during the project implementation process. He/she will be implementing FSL related trainings, monitoring and reporting of project activities, and work closely with local and county authorities especially the CAD and RRC.

Duty Station: Juba County Central Equatoria State.

Starting Date: The contract will start ONLY UPON PROJECT AND BUDGET APPROVAL.

Major Roles and Responsibilities

- Ensure that Agriculture and Food Security outputs meet project objectives and are aligned with International best practice and consider cross cutting issues such as gender and sustainability.
- Establish and monitor veg/crop groups and demo plots/APFS, in coordination with the CAD, as per project requirements and continuous follow up.
- Take lead in mobilization of community leaders and other stakeholders and facilitate the formation of Accountability to the affected population (AAP).
- Mobilize the community members, through the AAP and local authorities for meeting and beneficiaries' registration through the selected AAP members.
- Conduct a safety audit and selection of distribution sites in consultation with the county officials to ensure distribution sites are protected with ample space, shade and water source.
- Ensures selection of beneficiary households within the target areas are following the approved beneficiary selection criteria.
- Collaborate/facilitate in the on-job training in Agriculture and Food Security, and support project implementation for community groups and extension assistants.
- Constructively participate to project review and planning, review of progress of project objectives and targets in collaboration with supervisor and the team.
- Prepare order requests for project related requirement necessary to Programme implementation with support from project Manager and the Logistic department.



- Support the distribution of the emergency livelihood kits to the targeted beneficiaries and ensure post distribution monitoring conducted in accordance to the policy.
- Work in close coordination with the logistic to keep track of goods received and released and also act as logistic focal point during distribution.
- Support in the creation of farmer field schools for improved vegetable productions according to project needs.
- Coordinate with relevant partners (farmers group, County Agriculture Department, local authorities).
- Conduct community level awareness campaigns to promote good practices on COVID-19 safety rules and regulations.
- Ensure all financial supporting documents for all transactions submitted for consolidations.
- Document success stories from the project, with support from the project Manager.
- Perform any other project duty that may be assigned by supervisor from time to time.
- Produce required reports on project activities and others as requested.

Education

- Minimum of diploma in agriculture/crop production or any other related field.
- Agriculture technical and social training to a degree level is an advantage.

Work experience

- At least 2-3 years of professional experience implementing similar projects as well as experience in community mobilization, targeting, crop demonstration vegetable production, other agronomic practices.
- Farm Demonstration plot setting, community-led participatory planning, community economic empowerment and leadership development, seed multiplication, post-harvest management.
- Previous experience with climate smart agriculture, nutrition-sensitive agriculture models, Environmental conservation practices and conflict mapping will be considered as a relevant added advantage.
- Previous experience in FSL projects including inputs trading fairs and inputs distribution will be considered a strongly added advantage.
- Experience with community involvement in implementation of programs.
- Knowledge in agronomy, livestock production, horticulture.
- Energetic and motivated skills in community mobilization, training and team building.
- Extensive experience in computer (word, excel and PowerPoint) and report writing skills.
- Have knowledge of the local language spoken in **bari and Juba local Arabic**.
- Have high spirit of interpersonal and team work.
- Have strong individual initiative and willingness to work extra hours with minimum or without supervision.
