Purpose of the position:

The Nutrition Nurse is responsible for the overall Management and overseeing day to day operations of the Nutrition site ensuring that both Community management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM) and Maternal Infant and Young Child Nutrition (MIYCN) interventions are successfully implemented to the satisfaction of beneficiaries, World Vision South Sudan (WVSS), Support offices and Donor. The Nutrition nurse will ensure that programme beneficiaries, particularly children with Acute malnutrition are well managed with respect to supplies and medication and those children with SAM and medical complications are appropriately referred for Stabilization Centre for care

The holder of the position should communicate World Vision's Christian ethos and demonstrate a quality of spiritual life that is an example to others.

Key Responsibilities

- Administer appropriate nursing care to all children<5, pregnant and lactating women coming to the OTP/TSFP sites
- Support and building the capacity of Nutrition assistants and CNVs in their day to day activities.
- Ensure that the referral mechanism is working well from SC, OTP and TSFP

- Taking accurate medical history of children admitted in programme, accurate management and drug administration of routine medication in the OTP/SC sites and malaria testing and referral/treatment
- Ensure that accurate field data is kept at the OTP centers and site reports/data compiled into weekly and monthly reports and submitted to the Nutrition Project Co-coordinator.
- Work in close consultation and collaboration with the State Ministry of health in implementation of Nutrition activities
- Supervise and ensure that MIYCN Education, individual and group counselling is given at the facility and in the community and reported accordingly

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal and self-education, prior experience or on the job training

- Degree/Diploma / in nursing or related discipline
- Experience of not less than 2 years working a Nutrition related field
- Must be proficient in computer skills: MS Word, Excel, Power Point
- This position requires a person who is self-starter, who can accomplish the tasks with little or no supervision. He/she must be diligent in paperwork, have integrity and be able to cooperate with concerned business clients

Candidates should also be willing to live and work in very difficult and security-risk areas.

Candidate must be culturally sensitive and able to cope with tension, and take impartial neutral decisions as necessary.

- Must be prepared to work under pressure and be able to handle heavy caseload especially in times of emergency
- Good command of oral and written English is a must. Candidate must also be computer literate
 with proven skills in Spreadsheets and Word-processing. Should possess a clean driving license.
- A mature Christian who shows a desire to serve humanity and to strengthen his/her relationship with the Lord.
