Job Purpose

- Support with day-to-day monitoring of Water yard management committees (WMC).
- Accompany Sustainability Supervisor & WASH engineer to the field and understand the scope of work and compliance protocol. Subsequently, support with monitoring of progress in schools.
- Support the WASH team with maintaining a proper record of monitoring reports from author supervision contractor, Construction department and the community. Also track key indicators and update the team on regular progress.
- Be in touch with local water management committees and gather information regarding any key challenges and discuss with the team to identify a suitable response.
- Help to organize meetings including taking responsibility for the finalization of the meeting agenda, invitations, the production and distribution of documentation, and preparation of minutes of meetings. Distribute meeting reports and information and ensure follow-up on required actions.
- Helps in translation and editing of a variety of WASH-related documents.
- In coordination with WASH Technical team and management team, support with establishing a repository of approved IEC material for use in emergency and non-emergency situations.
- Any other task as required.

Desirable Qualification

- Be enrolled in a degree in engineering program or be a recent graduate in the area of Public Health, Civil, Sanitary, Architectural, IWRM or any other relevant discipline.
- Be proficient in local dialects in Greater Bahr el Ghazal
- Have strong academic performance as demonstrated by recent university or institution records or, if not available, a reference letter from an academic supervisor;
- Be willing to learn and genuinely interested in the field of WASH;
- Good documentation skills, judgment, initiative, high sense of responsibility, tact and discretion;
- Previous experience as a volunteer, demonstrated leadership /intern in NNGO, Companies or INGOs is considered as an advantage;
