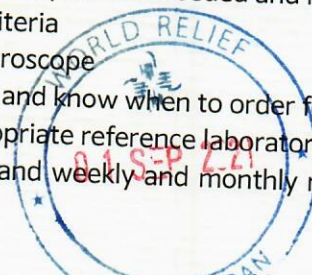

Position Summary:

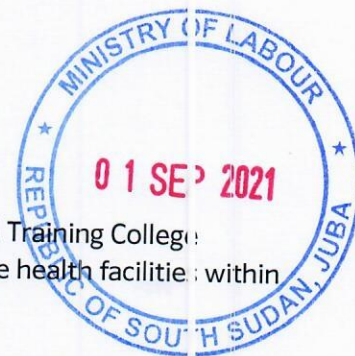
The medical laboratory Technician under supervision of the facility in-charge is intended to participate in the health care by promoting accurate diagnosis, surveillance of outbreak and control of disease in the community.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be able to manage a laboratory at the PHCU level
- Must carry out all basic laboratory tests
- Must incorporate quality procedures in all laboratory work
- Must practice safety and universal precaution procedures on all laboratories work at all times
- Be able to keep and maintain records
- Prepare the patient for specimen collections (properly cared and sited)
- Make sure you collect the right patient ID
- Do not mix patient ID number with others
- Collect the right specimen as prescribed by the clinical officer in the laboratory form sheet.
- Label all containers according to type of specimen needed and matching with the patient ID
- Establish rejection and acceptance criteria
- Prepare specimen adequately for microscope
- Be able to estimate the current stock and know when to order for laboratory supplies
- Be able to refer specimen to an appropriate reference laboratory.
- Be able to prepare and disseminate and weekly and monthly reports on 5th of new / month and weekly every Sunday



- Perform such other duties as may be assigned.



QUALIFICATIONS:

- Certificate in Medical Laboratory Sciences from a recognized Medical Training College
- 2 years working experience as a Laboratory Technician with in remote health facilities within South Sudan
- Fluency in both written and spoken English
- Knowledge of Nuer and Arabic is a plus
- Knowledge in software (Windows, Microsoft Office, Excel; Microsoft Project, Outlook and Other)
- Accountability – Takes responsibility for action and manages constructive criticisms
- Client Orientation – Works effectively well with client and stakeholders
- Continuous Learning – Promotes continuous learning for self and others
- Communication – Listens and communicates clearly, adapting delivery to the Audience
