Mechanic position profile

We are looking for a skilled **Mechanic** to assemble, maintain, and repair machinery and vehicles. You will be responsible for ensuring the functionality and reliability of machines, engines, and mechanical systems.

An excellent mechanic must have manual dexterity and great attention to detail. They must be able to work with various machines and tools as well as follow all safety precautions.

Key Responsibilities

- Build and assemble machines or mechanical components according to requirements
- Inspect machines, engines, transmissions, etc., and run diagnostic tests to discover functionality issues
- Conduct repairs aiming for maximum reliability
- Troubleshoot reported problems and resolve them in a timely manner
- Perform thorough maintenance on machinery, equipment and systems
- Clean and apply lubricants to machinery components
- Replenish fluids and components of engines and machinery
- Provide consultation on correct maintenance and preventative measures to machine or vehicle users
- Undertake other duties as assigned (e.g. repair of hydraulic systems, painting vehicles, etc.)
- Keep logs of work and report on issues
- Keeps equipment available for use by inspecting and testing vehicles; completing preventive
 maintenance such as engine tune-ups, oil changes, tire rotation, and changes, wheel balancing,
 and replacing filters.
- Maintains vehicle functional condition by listening to operator complaints; conducting
 inspections; repairing engine failures; repairing mechanical and electrical systems malfunctions;
 replacing parts and components; repairing body damage.
- Verifies vehicle serviceability by conducting test drives; and adjusting controls and systems.
- Compliance with state vehicle requirements by testing engine, safety, and combustion control standards.
