### **Purpose of the position:**

The Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) WASH/ IPC Coordinator will provide technical support to the Ebola Viral Disease preparedness and response with focus WASH and IPC. S/He will contribute to World Vision South Sudan Strategic Objective of improving health and wellbeing of beneficiary community through improving access to safe water and sanitation, and impacting good behavior change in hygiene practices in Greater Western Equatorial Zone.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- In liaison with the project manager, oversee EVD projects deliverables with focus on WASH/ IPC, and ensure all BH/ POE screening sites, the isolation facilities and the health facilities have the required materials and supplies for WASH and IPC in line with the MOH/ WASH standards for Ebola Viral Disease preparedness and response. Ensure that all protocols and IEC materials related to WASH and IPC for EVD preparedness and response are in place.
- Coordinate EVD related WASH/ IPC training /mentorship for health workers, hygienists and support staffs.
- Provide technical support to the EVD preparedness and response with focus on WASH and IPC at state level and work in collaboration with the state EVD taskforce and the EVD state rapid response team lead by WHO and the SMOH
- Together with project Manager, liaise with the State Ministry of Health and WHO to coordinate World Vision's preparedness and response in line with WASH/IPC standard operation procedures and the National guidelines



- Ensure that all EVD WASH /IPC activities are implemented in line with EVD projects' LGF and will monitor the sites where the activities are implemented to ensure quality in the service provision.
- Together with the WASH Manager, liaise with Juba based team, UNICEF, WFP and WASH cluster to ensure that WASH/IPC materials and supplies and PPE kits are requested in time and prepositioned in the isolation facilities and health facilities that are considered of high risk for EVD
- Collaborate with other partners in monitoring and ensure that good practices are replicated in WVSS EVD projects
- Coordinate community mobilization and sensitization on WASH activities under the project
- Follow up, inspect and ensure project material are delivered as per specified measurements at field level in timely way, and make follow with you supervisor those not delivered as per requisition.
- Prepare project documentation, progress status report, Bi-weekly updates report
- 
- Ensure the WASH /IPC intervention are aligned with the WV Partnership strategic direction, standards, child well-being outcomes, WASH technical approaches and internationally recognized WASH standards in Tambura State.
- Other duties assigned by the supervisor

### **Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience**

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

1. Academic qualifications in WASH/ Infection prevention and control or Environment Health Sciences. (Degree or Master Degree).
2. Should have minimum 5 years of experience in the relevant areas of water, sanitation and hygiene, water quality, public health, environmental health.
3. Practical experience in Ebola situation (having worked in Ebola outbreak situation) in West Africa or Democratic Republic of Congo.
4. Vast experience as a trainer/ mentor in infection prevention and control in EVD outbreak situation.
5. Vast experience in project planning and management.
6. Skills and experience in conducting water quality analysis using portable water testing kits.
7. Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Having demonstrated organizational, interpersonal and communication skills; organized, efficient, and able to work long hours to meet deadlines.
8. Willingness to work under pressure in unstable security and remote location with basic necessities a big plus.

**Candidates should also be willing to live and work in very difficult and security-risk areas.**
