Related to our advertised Request for Quotation **RFQ_WAU_2026_0012** Malteser International, herewith calls for tenders for drilling/installation/construction of Three (3) Indian Mark II Handpump Boreholes including water quality testing in all the borehole in Hai Lokoloko (Wau North Payam, Wau County), Ngomvu Boma (Bagarri Payam, Wau County) and Abou (Roc Roc Dong Payam, Jur River County) in Western Bahr El Ghazal State.

1. Description of the organization and its activities

Malteser International, the worldwide relief agency of the Sovereign Order of Malta for humanitarian aid, has more than 50 years of experience in humanitarian relief and covers around 100 projects in some 20 countries in Africa, Asia and the Americas, annually. It provides aid in all parts of the world without a distinction of religion, race or political persuasion. Christian values and the humanitarian principles of impartiality and independence are the foundation of its work.

In South Sudan, Malteser International operates in Juba, Yei, Renk and Wau. In these locations, its activities include Health and Nutrition, Food Security and Livelihood, Water Sanitation and Hygiene and Health Programs.

Objective of Invitation to tender:

In accordance with the overall targets of above-mentioned operations, Malteser International plans to drill Three (3) Boreholes installed with Indian Mark II Handpump including water quality testing in above stated Locations.

The technical specifications and conditions of the quoting process are described below. Companies are invited to present tenders complying with the requirements below specified.

2. Tenders Presentation

The tender shall be received via E-mail to: mb.procurement-juba@malteser-international.org by or before the submission deadline on **30th January 2026 at or before 12:00PM**

- The tender shall be written in English.
- The subject line of the email shall be **RFQ_WAU_2026_0012 for Borehole drilling**.
- The tender shall be submitted in **one email** including all documents as specified in 2 Content of tender
- The tender should be valid for **90 days after the deadline**.

3. Content of tender

All submitted tenders must conform to the requirements mentioned in the specification of bidding. Furthermore, they must include the following documents:

Part 1: Financial Proposal

Bidders are requested to provide the following cost details/breakdown in their financial quotation:

- Financial offer for drilling, installation and construction of three (3) Indian Mark II Handpump Boreholes including water quality testing in mentioned locations within WBEGS.

Part 2: Technical Proposal

The Technical Proposal shall include but not be limited to the following:

- Completed and signed bill of quantities
- Proposed workplan for the works



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- Details of technical staff composition
- List of equipment possessed
- Evidence of previous experience in similar works
- Technical drawings

Part 3 - Legal documents

- Copy of the company's certificate of incorporation
- Copy of Chamber of Commerce registration
- Copy Tax Identification Certificate
- Copy of Certificate of Operation

Part 4 – Supporting Documents

- Company's official address,
- Company's Financial Statement for the last three months
- Bank account details (where money would be paid)
- Proof of minimum 5 current references (contact information of clients/INGOs under the same service)

4. General conditions

- The tender shall be typed or written and signed by the legal representative of the bidder
- The winning company might be requested to provide catalogues, pictures, technical descriptions and/or samples of items at the order stage when required.
- The prices of the tender will be expressed in United States Dollars. The prices must be on unit price basis,
- Malteser International reserves the right to accept or reject all tenders depending on prevailing condition at the time.

6. Ownership of the tender

Malteser International reserves/funds ownership of all tenders received. Therefore, bidders will not be able to stipulate requirements that their tenders are to be returned.

7. Opening of the tender

The tenders will be opened on 2nd February 2026 in MI-Wau Office, South Sudan, by the Evaluation Committee. The selection process will be recorded in writing by the Evaluation Committee.

8. Tender Evaluation and Method

Tenders shall be evaluated according to the following procedure:

Firstly, tenders shall be checked on compliance with legal documents and evaluated on following

exclusion criteria:

1. Not bided according to the specifications
2. Not submitted within the deadline
3. Failure to submit all required documents (e.g., company registration, tax clearance, technical proposal, financial proposal).
4. Calculation errors above 2%

Secondly, tenders found to be compliant and fulfilled exclusion criteria will be evaluated by an internal evaluation committee through an evaluation tender analysis using the following selection criteria which include both technical and financial criteria:



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- **Financial Proposal (realistic pricing in relation to general market prices) 40%**
- **Documented drilling Experience (at least 5 years of service to non-governmental organizations) 20%**
- **Personnel Capacity (A team of qualified staff with relevant qualifications and experience) 20%**
- **Physical Presence in Wau, with available borehole drilling Machinery and Supplies 10%**
- **Delivery lead time 10%**

The selection criteria mentioned are to be weighed (%) and for each of the eligible tender ratings from 1-5 of the selection criteria will be applied from the internal evaluation committee according to project needs. The result of the analysis is an overall score that determines the further selection and award of the tenders.

Furthermore, the evaluation committee reserves the right to make a final decision and award a contract based on a physical visit, thus bidders are encouraged to be available for visits.

The set criteria shall be used to determine the most economically advantageous tender for contract award:

- a. The bidder's initial proposal should contain the tender's best terms from a cost or price and technical standpoint.
- b. If tenders are determined to be equivalent based on the selection criteria, price could then become the deciding criterion for award.
- c. Bidders are forewarned that an acceptable proposal with the lowest price may not be selected if award to a higher-priced proposal affords Malteser International a greater overall benefit,
- d. Malteser International will favorably evaluate a schedule, which shows earlier completion than Malteser International's required time frame. The Bidder's innovative approaches to accomplish early completion are encouraged.

9. Agreement and Payment Terms

- Evaluation Tender Analysis and justification based on responsiveness of the selected bidder by internal committee
- Contract Agreement will directly be issued to the selected contractors upon approval.
- The payment will be done in United States Dollar by bank transfer or cheque as specified below. Payment will be made within ten days upon receipt of work completion report and invoices for the completed Work.

Bidders, who will not receive any notification from Malteser International within one month after the deadline of RFQ, should consider their bids unsuccessful in the procurement process.
