The organization has its headquarters in Juba, with presence in Leer, Panyijiar, Mayendit, Koch, Mayom and Rubkona counties in Unity State, Maiwut and Longenchuk in Upper Nile state, Juba County in Central Equatoria, Ruweng Administrative Area and Aweil West in Northern Bahr el Ghazal. The organization's ultimate goal is to reach out to people across the entire South Sudan. The organization is currently implementing health and shelter/NFI projects in Panyijiar County and anticipate extending the health project across multiple locations. Job summary (Job Description)

The registered nurse will work under the direct supervision of the medical officer and will perform generalized duties such as management of patients, patient observation and care, health education and health promotion, as well as assist in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases and injuries at health facilities run by CH, screening for and referral of malnutrition cases among children under five for management as per the guidelines, and providing leadership in EPI, MCH, and CH mobile clinics under different project.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Open hospital admission cards for patients referred to the ward for admission
- Give the prescribed treatment according to the therapy form (type, date, time, route) and according with the condition of the patient (bedridden or not)
- Organize for bed space for admitted patients and provide IPD care
- Take Vital Signs, and report them on the chart
- Perform rapid test for malaria in accordance with recent medical history
- Observe patients and immediately call for the doctor in case of emergency or danger signs
- Provide first aid treatment in case of life-threatening situations where there is no clinical officer or doctor promptly available
- Take an i.v line, perform bladder catheterization, shave and or dress patients with a clean gown before any surgical intervention

- Teach patients how to use latrine and bathrooms.
- Instruct the patient about waste collection
- If prescribed by doctor feed the patient through nasogastric tube.
- Assist the doctor or clinical officer during any invasive procedure
- Dress wounds, respecting the steps of aseptic techniques
- Compilation of timely and quality reports and submission to the clinical officer on the required time lines
- Any other duties assigned by the supervisor

Project Reporting

- Provide regular and timely update of mobilization and surveillance efforts to the clinical officer in accordance to the set reporting timelines.
- Ensure preparation and submission of weekly health updates to the clinical officer.
- Contribute to preparation of internal project activity narrative of implementation status as required by the project donors.

- Professional technical experience, with work experience in a clinical setting.
- Good knowledge of MOH procedures and guidelines for Hospital, PHCC and PHCU in South Sudan

- Minimum 2 years of proven experience in health education and health promotion preferably in an NGO setting
- Excellent writing and reporting skills.
