The delivery of goods shall be at CSS Filed Office in Torit Dioceses and to Lafon and Budi Counties to selected schools. Our office is in Torit (Caritas Diocese of Torit or to the project sites) in Lafon and Budi Counties. We are in Juba Town- South Sudan.

Nature of Works:

- Construction of 9 Temporary Learning Space (TLS) of two classroom each According to MOGEI Approved TLS Design in Lafon and Budi Counties -Eastern Equatoria state.
- CSS is seeking potential qualified and Experienced Construction Company from South Sudan to bid for the Construction of 9 TLS in Lafon and Budi Counties -Eastern Equatoria.

Documents to be submitted are:

- Original company technical and financial proposals with the final total cost.
- Valid certificate of incorporation (including a copy of updated stamp
- Valid Business operational licenses
- Valid Tax clearance certificate
- Minimum of three (3) contract/purchased orders of similar nature, value and complexity implemented during the last 3 years.

- Vendors are strongly recommended to attach catalogue of items with Quote.

- CSS reserved the right to awards in whole or in part unless otherwise stipulated by the vendors in which Case CSS will consider all factors at the time of evaluating the bid.
- Items that include artwork and sample for approval will be required production and mass printing.

- The Vendor further warrants that:
 - (a) It shall take all appropriate measures to prevent actual, attempted or threatened sexual exploitation or abuse (SEA) by its employees or any other persons engaged and controlled by it to perform any activities under this tender. In addition, it shall take all appropriate measures to prohibit its employees or other persons engaged and controlled by it from exchanging any money, goods, or services at their disposal under this bid, for sexual favours or activities.
 - (b) It shall strongly discourage sexual relationships between its employees and CSS beneficiaries, and between any other person engaged and controlled by it to perform activities under this tender and CSS beneficiaries.
 - (c) It shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that its employees or any other persons engaged and controlled by it to perform any activities under this bid do not engage in sexual activity with children (persons under the age of 18) regardless of the age of majority or age of consent locally. Mistaken belief regarding the age of a child is not a defence.  - (d) It shall report all and any complaints or concerns regarding possible SEA by its employees, any other persons engaged and controlled by it to perform any activities under this bid, or CSS personnel; and it shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that its employees or any other persons engaged and controlled by it to perform any activities under this tender shall report to CSS and/or the Vendor any complaints or concerns regarding possible SEA.
 - (e) It shall take all necessary measures to investigate allegations or suspicions of SEA and take appropriate corrective action, including disciplinary action, against its employee or any other person engaged and controlled by it to perform any activities under this tender who is found to have committed SEA.

Caritas South Sudan has entered into partnership agreement with UNICEF South Sudan to implement Global Education for Partnership (GEP) project title: Improving Access to Quality Education in Lafon and Budi counties, Eastern Equatoria State.

The overall objective of the project is to improve equitable access to quality Education in Eastern Equatorial through improved education infrastructure improvement through construction of 9 TLS

(Longior Payam at Losou Primary school, Mura-Lopit Payam at Habirongi Primary school, Bule Payam at Haba Primary schools) in Lafon County and Ngauro Payam at Ngatalani Primary school in Budi County, provision of school supplies, training of SMC /PTA and Advocate for back to school through back to schools' campaigns.

The Project consists of four output with the objective of having Improved Access to Quality Education for Out-of-School Children in Torit County through construction of 8 TLS (16 Classrooms) in 4 supported schools in Lafon and Budi counties of Eastern Equatoria, South Sudan: This activity aims at promoting access to basic primary education for out-of-school children and by addressing some of the current education gaps especially lack of school infrastructure or learning space for learners The Construction of 16 f classrooms under 8 TLS in the 4 supported schools will increased on enrollment , school attendance and retention rate in the supported schools .
