The Livelihoods Program manager will lead the implementation of livelihoods response programming to promote more resilient livelihoods in order to increase people's autonomy, enabling them to generate income that meets their basic needs, even in times of crisis.therefore applicants are encouraged to apply and job holder will become part of the ASIMO working team in livelihoods Response program and integrated Gender Based Voilence intervention.

 technologies and practices and provide technical assistance where there are gaps.

- Capacity building of VSLAs or MSEs groups in all the program areas of intervention.
- Co Work closely in teamwork with livelihoods and integrated protection team as well as other program teams such as cash for work, agriculture, and Logistics, finance, and Health.
- Develop detailed project plans with associated milestones and work with internal and external personnel to ensure goals are met.
- Manage multiple work streams and projects, allocating resources across them in the most efficient manner to deliver to project plans
- Maintains and facilitates accurate and timely project reporting of multi Sectors in collaboration with other staff and state focal persons.
