The Hospital Coordinator is to be based in Aweil State Hospital and plays a key role in Consortium Secondary Health Care Programs in the hospital HealthNet TPO implements in Consortium with Malaria Consortium (lead agency) and other stakeholders present in the Hospital while at the same time, providing support to primary Health Care services provided across the health facilities in Aweil Center County

Main Responsibilities:

- Ensure medical service of high and consistent quality are provided in all departments at Aweil State Hospital
- Take charge of the medical supplies and equipment and ensure all the supplies and equipment are availed for services provision.
- Participate and provide input in the senior management meeting of the hospital and ensure that departmental concerns and issued raised are followed and addressed.
- Organize and Participate in ground rounds and Continuous Medical Education (CME) sessions for clinical staff and ensure that staff capacity in the departments is enhanced in order to improve quality of care.
- Monitor activities of the departments; both technical and administrative while ensuring high quality services are rendered
- Ensure that hospital is represented in various inter-NGO or any other official meetings within and

outside the hospital.

- Provide administrative support to the hospital management team and ensure timely implementation of activities.
- · Participate in hospital quarterly review and audit sessions and organize departmental audit, and review meetings and submit report findings to the Senior Public Health Adviser.
- Supervise and ensure that all the departmental staff maintain all medical safety procedures and apply highest hygiene standard.
- Accountable for the overall hospital performance of the hospital departments and ensure the staff operating in the departments are equally accountable for their time and service.
- Plan and ensure adequate (24hrs including night shifts) coverage of all the departments by staff by developing of duty rosters in coordination with the hospital management.
- Coordinate activities of other project staff (primary health care supervisor, finance officer, pharmacists etc) for effective delivery of project activities and timely reporting.
- Manage HealthNet TPO's HPF3 budget under Aweil Centre County.
- Create an enabling environment for dialogue, information sharing, partnerships and, and cooperation amongst stakeholders operating in the hospital, Government structures in Aweil Center County and NBEG state at large when delivering project interventions.
- Participate in reviewing health activities data quality, analysis and preparation of routine and adhoc reports for program activities in the hospital and Aweil Center County in general
- Track the performance of project activities and outputs against expected results for the hospital and other health facilities in the county and adjust implementation processes to ensure the project progresses towards intended outcomes
- Prepare and ensure SOP and quality assurance practices are in place across health sector resulting into reduction in epidemiological cases.
- Any other duty as assigned by the line manager
