### BACKGROUND

HRP is a member of AfriYAN South Sudan and NGO FORUM, and it is aimed at supporting grass root communities in developmental projects like Sexual Reproductive Health, Menstrual Hygiene Management, Comprehensive Sexual Education, Gender Based Violence, Peace Building, Food security & Livelihood, and Education.

Hope Reviving Platform is currently running a project in Torit and seeks the competence of a Field Coordinator for a 6-month period with possible extension depending on availability of projects.

## Description

Hope Reviving Platform is hiring a Field Coordinator to manage our current project in Torit and we expect the Field Coordinator to be able to use insights obtained during interactions with authorities, partners, and beneficiaries to steer and supervise the deployment of new projects.

The Field Coordinator will be required to populate evaluative frameworks provided for the projects, liaise with stakeholders on the ground and then submit data collected to immediate supervisor.

The Field Coordinator should maintain a trustworthy presence amongst our project's beneficiaries.

The Field Coordinator should be able to carry out arithmetical calculations with ease and should have very good writing skills

# **Field Coordinator Duties and Responsibilities**

- Implementation of Projects in field locations
- Formulate evaluative resources to guide your fieldwork and keep track of project.
- Inspect project sites to ascertain the project progress.
- Confer with project beneficiaries and support staff to evaluate uptake, pitfalls, and areas changes.
- Collect samples, where possible, for subsequent inspection.
- Input data into suitable software and then arranging this to facilitate analysis.
- Liaising with local authorities
- Liaise with program manager to ensure that all new and ongoing project adhere to accountability requirements for new projects/programmes and conducting relevant evaluations for ongoing projects to meet HRPs standards.
- Represent HRP in technical meetings, forums and other events
- Lead and coordinate all assessments, evaluations and performance evaluation tasks including planning and reporting on the same.
- Maintain and update the overall program indicator tracker based on submissions from the program
- Collaborate with HRP staff to ensure that data is collected, compiled, checked for its quality and completeness in compliance with HRP and donor standards of data quality
