FUNCTION: Water & Habitat Technician – Mechanical

PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT: JUBA - Working hours split: 75% in the field in Gumbo / and 25% in the office.

PURPOSE

WatHab Technician 1 implements small or non-complex engineering projects within the scope of ICRC's Juba Urban Water Project Phase 2 and under the close supervision and guidance of their hierarchical superior. S/he personally carries out on-site works and monitors them for quality control and compliance with design documents. S/he has a close working relationship with external stakeholders related to their projects.

FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

- Supervision & quality control of assembling, testing and maintaining pipelines including laying, welding, fitting DI, HDPE, PVC and CS pipes for pipelines that include valves, filters, strainers
- Supervision & quality control of installation of steel water tanks and mechanical water industry equipment including but not limited to pumps, mixers
- Reading, interpreting and preparing pipeline drawings, diagrams and schematics
- Preparing technical documents including but not limited to bill of quantities, installation & operation and maintenance manuals
- Monitors project implementation for compliance with project documents, ICRC standards, and local building codes/standards, and ensures corrective action is taken if necessary.
- Conducts quality control during installations
- Compiles site reports on project implementation at intervals set by the project manager. Provides information to their supervisor and project colleagues on stakeholder issues, security and site progress.
- Monitor working hours of generators and ensure routine maintenance is carried out as per standard procedures.
- Monitor the performance of installed equipment's e.g pumps, pressure gauges, water meters etc and report any malfunction.
- Holding working advances when necessary for field activities and document the expenses in line with ICRC regulations.

Education/Professional Experience Required:

- Engineering or technician diploma and / or technical vocational training or apprenticeship in mechanics, hydraulics, water technology or any similar field of expertise
- Excellent command (spoken and written) of Juba Arabic and English
- 2-3 years professional experience in the technical area of the position
