In 2009, PSI started a Home Management of Malaria (HMM) program for children under five years old. Since then, HMM has evolved into a broader Integrated Community Case Management (ICCM) program with the addition of pneumonia, diarrhea and acute malnutrition interventions.

PSI South Sudan seeks qualified, dynamic candidates for the LLIN Distribution Coordinator position that will be a temporary consultancy based in Juba for a period of 6-9 months. Under the Global Fund PSI South Sudan leads as the Principal Recipient on the malaria portfolio in partnership with the Government of South Sudan. A main activity under the portfolio is the planning and implementation of mass distribution campaigns long lasting insecticide-treated mosquito nets (LLIN), estimated to be almost 8 million LLINs before the end of 2020. The role of the LLIN Distribution Coordinator is to act as the focal point for PSI South Sudan at National level and the State level and to ensure smooth implementation of all distribution related activities in all states by the sub-recipients. This is a 6-9 month consultancy position based out of Juba and will be expected to travel at least 50% of the time.

- ❖ Responsible for financial and administrative issues related to LLIN distribution at the state level with Program Director and Deputy Director
- ❖ Responsible for management and distribution of all related materials to LLIN distribution
- ❖ Oversee IEC activities related to LLIN distribution at the state level
- ❖ Prepare monthly reports on activities
- ❖ Any other activities as requested by the PSI South Sudan Senior Management Team
