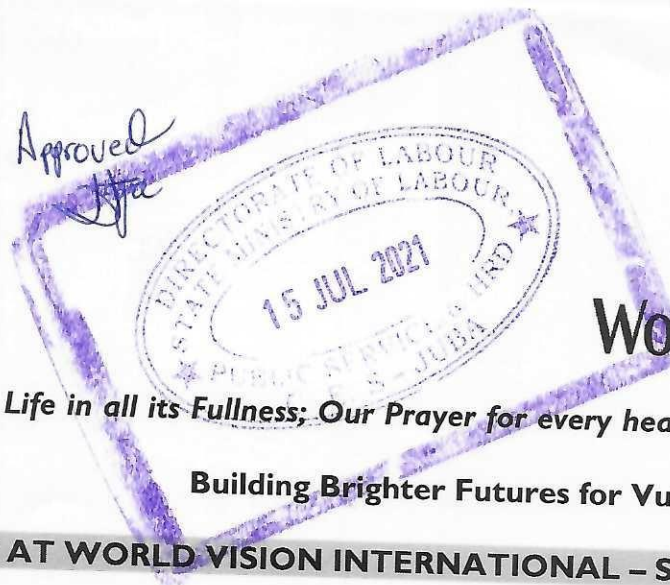

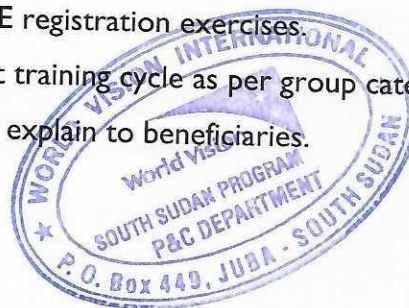

Purpose of the position:

The Field Facilitator be facilitating on Nutrition Module in order to ensure that beneficiaries are well equipped for self-resilience under the supervision of the Field Officers: his/her duties and responsibilities shall include the following.

Major Responsibilities

- Facilitate the Nutrition module to the project beneficiaries during the training.
- Inform the project management committee on training workshops dates and the locations.
- Assist in the SCOPE registration exercises.
- To inform the beneficiaries on the next training cycle as per group category.
- To assist the project officers on SCOPE registration exercises.
- To inform the beneficiaries on the next training cycle as per group category.
- To determining course participation to explain to beneficiaries.



- To make a suitable facility for conducting the training workshops.
- Inform the beneficiaries on the payment date with a consultation with project officers and galaxy.
- To inform the beneficiaries about time when there any make up on training workshop.
- Track and mark daily attendance register.
- Compile attendance report and submit to the Field Officer at the end of each training cycle.

Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may require through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- At least a diploma or Bachelor degree in area of Nutrition
- Excellent in verbal and written English communication skills, and Arabic Language “Juba Arabic” is a MUST as one would be deployed in any part of Juba Urban either-or Peri Urban.
- Previous work experiences in facilitating training are preferable.
- Should be an excellent team player, who can show positive attitude in leading a team.
- Willing to be deployed in any part of the Juba Urban Centers.
- Good diplomatic/discipline skills in interacting with government agencies, civil society organization and other developmental organizations.
- Only South Sudanese national are encouraged to apply.
