### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

#### Job purpose:

TOCH is seeking Protection Programme Manager to oversee the overall activities of the Protection sector in the field of General protection, GBV, and CP, which are implemented in the Greater Bahr el Gazal states.

The Protection programme Manager is in charge of protection sector to ensure an accurate, proper, timely and high quality implementation of Protection Needs of Vulnerable Children and women through Child Protection Case Management System, PSS,GBV Case management, capacity building etc that means s/he has a major responsibility for the protection projects being implemented by TOCH.

The position will be based in Juba TOCH Head office with frequent travels to the field/project locations. The Protection programme Manager is responsible for the overall activities' planning, execution and reporting of his/her projects. He/she is directly assigned to, and responsible of the supervision of all logistics, HR, financial and overall functioning aspects of the projects.





# Functional and hierarchical reporting lines:

The Protection Programme Manager directly reports to the Head of Programs and is under the overall supervision of Executive Director. The Protection Project Manager is expected to coordinate closely with other departments within TOCH, including Food Security and Livelihoods, WASH, Education, Peace building as well as supporting departments such as Procurement, Finance, HR and M&E.

The Main tasks of this position includes: Project management, Program quality, coordination, team management administration

### Team Management

- Ensures that a daily support as well as punctual trainings are organized and provided in order to develop and strengthen the programmatic technical skills of the team implementing the Project.
- Encourages effective team work, especially on issues related to cross-sectorial collaboration.
