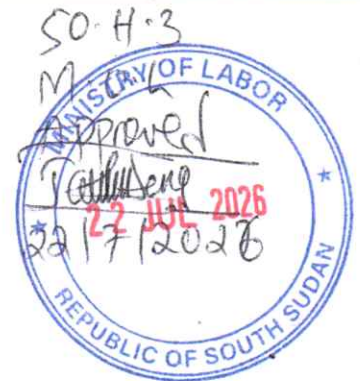

The agency places emphasis on promotion of Peace and peaceful co-existence among communities as the benchmark for socio-economic prosperity. CIDO implements Protection, Women Rights and Empowerment, Education, Human Rights, Health and Nutrition Projects.

CIDO is looking for a suitable candidate to fill the position of Health&Nutrition Manager for **“an intergrated Health and Protection project .**

Job overview

The overall purpose of the Health and Nutrition Manager position is to coordinate and report on all activities of Health and Protection .

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

Coordination/Technical

- Coordinate pertinent project issues with the local authority, partners , clusters and other coordination bodies at the field level.
- Coordinate all the sectoral activities
- Coordinate the work of clinical mobile team on ground
- Coordinate core Pipeline items and ensure stock is with Juba Team



- Compile weekly and monthly reports .
- Line manage staff including Project managers - Nurses, Midwives, Community Health Workers, nursing assistants, vaccinators with tasks including training, attendance and reviewing/approve leave requests in coordination with the Health Manager
- Implement weekly meetings with staff
- Represent CIDO in relevant meetings in Akobo including the health cluster and the ICCWG .
- Represent CIDO in meetings with NGO partners, the CHD & other local authorities
- Assist Drug dispenser and other clinic staffs in preparing stock requests each day to provide to the health team
- Ensure all stocks required are in the clinic at all times or ensure that the health team is aware of the stock out
- Ensure any violations of the CIDO sexual abuse and exploitation code of conduct are reported to the PSEA focal point. The reporting of violations is an obligation on the part of all staff members.
- Assist where necessary in undertaking activities that aim to prevent the occurrence of sexual abuse and exploitation of beneficiaries by CIDO and other humanitarian workers.

Required Professional and Technical Skills:

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized institution with a confirmed post-qualification experience.
- 2-3 years of experience in hospital and/or humanitarian work is an added advantage
- Registered and with a valid practicing license
- Excellent communication skills, Strong interpersonal skills, creativity, flexibility, adaptability and empathy.
- Proven ability to work cooperatively with others in a team environment
- Must be ready to work under minimal supervision
- Confirmed track record of providing professional patient care
- Spoken and written English and spoken Arabic
- Previous clinical experience
- Knowledge of the local language is an asset
- Literacy in computer skills (word, Excel & power-point)
- Thorough knowledge and skills of primary health care related programs in rural situations
General understanding of health service delivery, especially those related to women and children
- Proven abilities in managing successful Primary Health Care Programmes in South Sudan
- Energetic and self-motivated, with skills in community mobilization, training, and teambuilding
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines
