JOB VACANCY: FSL Project Field Assistant

Duty Station: Kapoeta East County (1 positions), East Equatoria State (EES)

Role description

The **FSL Project field assistant** will support AVSI Food Security and Livelihood (FSL) activities and especially in:

- Support the implementation n of FFS/APFS activities
- Support the implementation n of IGA/Alternative livelihoods activities activities
- Support implementation n of NRM activities
- 90% field based, 10% office based

Specific Duties

1. Ensure that Agriculture and Food Security outputs meet activity targets and are aligned with International best practice and consider cross cutting issues such as gender and sustainability;
2. Ensure criteria for beneficiary selection are respected and observed
3. Establishment, in coordination and collaboration with the CAD, all APFS as per project requirements and continuous follow up and field visits;
4. Support in the creation of committees for water usage, natural resources etc... according to project needs and continuous follow up and field visits;
5. Ensure appropriate support to the field sites where the program is implemented through regular visits;
6. Collaborate during facilitation in the on-job training in Agriculture and Food Security and NRM
7. Participated in the review of progress of project objectives and targets in collaboration with the project officer and specialist;
8. Monitor and write weekly reports on project activities up to standards;
9. Provide support to other AVSI FSL projects as may be required.
