Tasks & responsibilities	The SCOPE CODA Technical Support Officer will be responsible for the roll out technical guidance, device maintenance and ensure synchronisation of all CODA Data. As such he/she be responsible to:  " Carry out CODA mPOS equipment maintenance tasks and ensure equipment required for AAH staffs is available and performing at an optimum level.  Support the AAH IT Officer and WFP CODA IT specialists to set-up IT equipment, data networks and power sources required to effectively support the project activities at designated service outlets.  Provide on-site IT technical support to nutrition staff and respond to a variety of queries about technology and systems to assist them to deliver their services.  Ensure timely and complete synchronization of devices to online repository.
