POSITION: COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

LOCATION: GANYIEL, PANYIJAR COUNTY

Job summary (Job Description)

The community health workers will work under the direct supervision of the clinical officer and will perform generalized duties such as health education and health promotion, mobilization of community members for diagnosis and treatment of diseases and injuries at health facilities run by CH, screening for and referral of malnutrition cases among children under five for management as per the guidelines, mobilizing communities for purposes of EPI, MCH, and attending of CH mobile clinics under the project.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Conduct active community social mobilization
- Preparation of monthly work plan for activities and submit the plan to the supervisor
- Conduct nutrition and health education, and practical demonstration during health promotion and awareness sessions
- Monthly stock taking of supplies
- Conduct screening for malnutrition among children under five and carry out appropriate action as per the guideline
- Referral of cases of acute malnutrition to Nutrition sites as per admission guidelines
- Take part in OVC and EPI campaigns
- Refer pregnant women for ANC, skilled birth attendance and PNC at the nearest facilities
- Take part in health and nutrition assessments
- Compilation of timely and quality reports and submission to the clinical officer on the required time lines
- Any other duties assigned by your supervisor

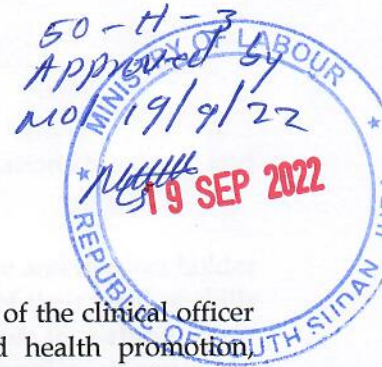
Project Reporting

- Provide regular and timely update of mobilization and surveillance efforts to the clinical officer in accordance to the set reporting timelines.
- Ensure preparation and submission of weekly health updates to the clinical officer.
- Contribute to preparation of internal project activity narrative of implementation status as required by the project donors.

a) Education and Experience

- A diploma or certificate in Nursing, Community Health, Community Development, Social Work or other related discipline.



- Minimum 2 years of proven experience in health education and health promotion preferably in an NGO setting.
- Excellent writing and reporting skills.

- Flexibility in approach and an ability to adapt to varying demands and work hours
- Ability to identify problems and resolve them
- Ability to work unsupervised
- Proficient skills and experience in working with MS Office
