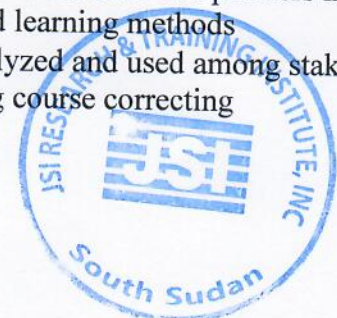
Position Description

This position is for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience Project (MIHR) in South Sudan, implemented by IMA World Health, with JSI Research & Training Institute, Inc., GOAL USA Fund, and Pathfinder International.

The Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning (MEL) Officer/Data Analyst for South Sudan MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience (MIHR) will support the implementation of program-level MEL activities, including overseeing program data collection and quality, in close collaboration with the local and HQ MEL teams. The position will be based in Juba, South Sudan and will report to the Senior MEL Advisor. This position is contingent upon funder approval of key personnel and availability of funds.

Key Responsibilities

- Support the implementation of the project's M&E activities, including 1) monitoring of project indicators; 2) implementation of baseline and routine project monitoring activities; 3) coordinate and strengthen data collection, data cleaning, data quality, and data analysis (quantitative and qualitative); 4) synthesizing data and study outcomes for presentation in reports and presentations; and 5) quality assurance and auditing of data
- Support the implementation of the project's assessment, research, and evaluation activities, which may include performance evaluations, surveys, formative research, qualitative studies, and rapid/special studies
- Contribute to work plans, quarterly and annual reports, financial reports, and other reports and papers summarizing project results and evidence
- Conduct trainings and other capacity building efforts for staff and partners in M&E, data collection and management, and research and learning methods
- Ensure that data from the project is collected, analyzed and used among stakeholders for learning and policy development and on-going course correcting
