Position Summary:

The field monitor will be responsible for monitoring and verifying activities implemented by USAID/South Sudan's Implementing partners (IPs) in the target counties. S/he will also be responsible for collecting data on contextual indicators to assess external factors that could affect activity implementation on the ground. The field monitor will assist in designing and refining monitoring tools and protocols and will report to Senior Field Monitor. This is a Long-Term Technical Assistance (LTTA) Position based in Juba.

Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the review of third-party monitoring and protocols as warranted.
- Support the design, pre-test, and roll out of new monitoring and verification tools as required.
- Conduct site visits to monitor and verify IP activities.
- Conduct context monitoring to assess factors that could affect implementation of USAID/South Sudan's
 activities.
- Prepare clear and concise monitoring reports that enrich the Mission's learning agenda.
- Deliver presentations on TPM findings to USAID/South Sudan and its IPs.
- Conduct any other activities as assigned by the TPM Manager from time to time.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in social science or related field.
- At least three (3) years of experience monitoring and/or implementing development projects.
- Demonstrable working knowledge of M&E principles.
- · Experience in designing tools and protocols for data collection, analysis, reporting.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- · Excellent computer skills.
- Working knowledge of Juba Arabic and one or two local languages preferred.
- Experience working in complex field environments within South Sudan
- · Fluency in oral and written English required.
