Main Job Purpose:

The post holder, with support from WASH Assistance shall be responsible for WASH activities, community mobilisation, and help in organizing campaigns and data collection at the field level.

General Objective:

The main purpose of this position is to mobilize communities towards achieving good sanitation and hygiene practices as well as promoting good safe water seeking behaviour and also organizing campaigns with directives from the WASH Assistant.



JOB FUNCTIONS (Roles & Responsibilities):

- 1. Provide culturally appropriate health education and information sharing on WASH issues.
- 2. Advocate for needs and perspectives of community members served
- 3. Provide cultural link between organizations and communities
- 4. Provide informal counseling, coaching, or social support to the beneficiaries
- 5. Make sure people get access to WASH related information and are aware of key effective remedies
- 6. Help community members increase health knowledge and be self-sufficient, especially on WASH related diseases.
- 7. S/he will assist WASH Assistant in the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of WASH activities in Kapoeta East
- 8. Assist WASH Assistant in organizing training of Water user group/committee organizing sessions, preparing materials, keeping record of attendees; ensuring trainings are well balanced in terms of gender and age.
- 9. Provides technical knowledge and guidance to promote good practices of sanitation and hygiene in the communities of Kapoeta
- 10. Assist WASH assistant to Plan and organize Focus Group Discussions and community meetings to advice target (Leaders and beneficiaries) on hygiene promotion campaigns.
- 11. S/he will assist WASH Assistant to organize clean up campaigns in schools, markets, water points and other places identified to be of high risk especially during emergencies or outbreaks.
- 12. Any other duties that shall be assigned by the supervisor as or when need arises.

- A Secondary school certificate, certificate in Nursing, CHW certificate.
- Community health worker certificate, Primary Eight school leaver.
