Overall Job Purpose:

The nutrition Coordinator will support the Nutrition Manager in the overall management and supervision of planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of nutrition projects.

The Coordinator will also work closely with all staff and the County Health Departments to build staff capacity to ensure high standards of Program Quality, management of CMAM components of the program as well as promoting community-based nutrition services.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

a) Programme Quality:

Lead the continuous assessment of nutrition related needs and ensure that these
are appropriately reflected in new concept notes and project notifications

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- Ensure regular project monitoring and Accountability to affected persons working closely with other sectors like WASH and Food Security and Livelihoods.
- Regularly assess and provide feedback and recommendations on the quality of nutrition programmes and interventions during field visits.
- Maintain resource library for the nutrition team including the relevant checklists, standards and guidelines for regular on-site training and support supervision.
- Provide guidance on routine nutrition monitoring and evaluation activities.
- Support the Nutrition Manager in ensuring timely submission of accurate reports (Weekly, Monthly, Quarterly) Hilfe Zur Selbsthilfe and donors report as required.
- Support the Nutrition Manager to closely monitor budget to avoid over or underspending and accurate and timely financial reports are generated with support from finance team.
- Ensure that the program is well integrated to the health system, WASH, FSL and community level.
- Monitor the usages of supplies in the centers, main warehouse, and that records are accurate kept and stock cards well balance.
- Work closely with logistic team to ensure that project materials are timely ordered, procured on time, transported to the sites and properly recorded, stored and used for intended purpose.
- Participate in recruitment of local staffs and selection of CNVs per the Hiffe Zur Selbsthilfe South Sudan HR protocol.
- Participate in project proposal development as required.

b) Capacity Building

- Ensure all Nutrition Programme staff, partners and CNVs receive the necessary and appropriate technical support and training to deliver on their mandate.
- Regularly train staff in treatment and prevention of both chronic and acute malnutrition and management of the Stabilization Centers.
- Ensure that partners, community and staffs understand the project through participatory meetings, community engagement, refresher trainings.

c) Management

- Support and deputize for the Nutrition Manager in budget management, donor reporting and staff management.
- Attend sub national nutrition cluster coordination meetings as delegated by the Nutrition Manager.
- Coordinate with the stake holders in various levels (CHD, SMOH, and WFP, UNICEF-Partners and community local leaders) on matters of Programme Quality.
- Conduct community feedback meetings at community level with community leaders in collaboration with the MEAL Team.
- Providing regular feedback on project/program activities for analysis and reporting;
- Participate in gap analysis assessments missions and discussions with WFP, UNICEF, SMOH/CHD and identify gaps for potential expansions

- Demonstrable Nutrition management experience, including budget holding and capacity building responsibility
- At least 3 years of experience in emergency nutrition work and the design and implementation of feeding programmes (SAM, CMAM, IYCF-e), including monitoring and evaluation
- Experience in conducting nutrition assessments and an understanding of nutritional surveillance and information systems.
- Experience of working with local partners and local authorities and building capacity
- Proven capacity to supervise, train and coach staff
- Willingness and capacity to be flexible and accommodating when faced with difficult and frustrating working conditions
- · Ability and willingness to frequently travel and stay at the field

- Experience and ability to represent HELP in South Sudan's nutrition work in external meetings
- Demonstrable ability at report writing and excellent communication skills
