Job Title: Woman Empowerment Supervisor

Project: Women Economic Empowerment and Resilience Project.

Duty Station: Based in Wau with activities locations in Cueibet, Aweil West and Tonj North

Reports to: WASH Manager.

### Position Overview

The Woman Empowerment Supervisor will lead and coordinate initiatives that strengthen women's economic resilience and social leadership within communities served by the Water for South Sudan Foundation. This role focuses on equipping women with practical skills, fostering entrepreneurship, enhancing governance capacity, and promoting awareness on gender-based violence (GBV) prevention.

### Key Responsibilities

- **Skills Development & Training**
  - Conduct hands-on training in tailoring skills including use of straight lines and overlock machines.
  - Training women groups on re-usable menstrual pad production.
  - Guide and train women group in cloth and *kitenge* designing, including free wears.
  - Undertake follow-up activities to mentor the tailoring groups of Udhum and Tonj North on the similar activities listed above including designing and embroiling local bedsheets.
  - Trouble shooting and repair of tailoring machines
- **Entrepreneurship & Marketing**
  - Support women in marketing their products locally.
  - Provide mentorship on branding and pricing.
- **Leadership & Governance**
  - Deliver training on women's leadership skills to build confidence and representation.
  - Strengthen group governance structures, ensuring transparency and accountability.
  - Train women's groups on record keeping, financial literacy, and documentation.
- **Awareness & Advocacy**
  - Organize awareness sessions on GBV prevention to the women group.



- Promote safe spaces for dialogue among women group.

### Qualifications and skills required

- Diploma or degree in Social Work, Community Development, Gender Studies, or related field.
- Proven experience in women's empowerment, vocational training, or community mobilization.
- Strong facilitation and mentorship skills.
- Knowledge of tailoring, production of re-usable menstrual pads, textile /kitenge design, Bedsheet embroidery, and small-scale product marketing.
- Familiarity with GBV prevention strategies and community sensitization approaches.
- Ability to develop weekly, and monthly activities plans and skills of report writing.
- Knowledge of raising purchase requests, work advances, and accounting for work advances.
- Excellent communication, organizational, and record-keeping abilities.
- Ability to work well with and facilitate training to illiterate beneficiaries.

- Good report writing skills.
- Passion for women's empowerment and economic resilience.
- Ability to work collaboratively with diverse community groups.
- Strong leadership and problem-solving skills.
- Cultural sensitivity and respect for local traditions and beneficiaries.
