Minimum of Diploma in Peace Building/Community Development from an accredited University with at least 2 years' experience in conflict related assessments, translation of English to local languages and or hand on experience with local leaders, youth, and community members.

- Familiarity with the complexities of accountability, organizational growth and change, and the ethical dimensions of UN work.
