NEPWU is seeking for services of an Audit firm with appropriate knowledge, skills, experience, and competency to audit its financial records for financial year starting January 2021 to December 2021 and January 2022 to December 2022

The objective of the Audit.

The objective of the external audit is to express a professional audit opinion in accordance with International Standards on Auditing on whether:-

The organizational financial statements of NEPWU, in all material respects, are in conformity with the applicable International Financial Reporting Standards and the Financial Management Policy of the Organization.

The financial statements of projects that require separate audit reports [1], in all material respects, are in conformity with the applicable Financial Management Policy of NEPWU and applicable donor financing agreements.



Audit Duration

The audit report (on the organizational accounts and separate project reports) including the financial statements, the management letter including the NEPWU Secretariat's responses should be received by NEPWU within **three on month** after the end of the exercise.

Qualifications of the Audit firm.

The auditor must be completely impartial and independent from all aspects of management or financial interests of the organization;

- The auditor shall not, during the period covered by the audit nor during the undertaking of the audit, be employed by, serve as advisers or mentors for, or have any financial or business relationships with the organization.
- The auditor shall be registered with the (Institute of Certified Public Accountants and must demonstrate that they possess appropriate professional qualifications and suitable experience in accounting and auditing the accounts of entities comparable in size and complexity to the entity being audited;
- Curriculum Vitae (CVs) must be provided to NEPWU by the Partner of the firm of auditors who
 shall be responsible for signing the opinion, together with the CVs of key personnel proposed as part
 of the audit team. The CVs shall include details of audits carried out by the concerned staff, including
 ongoing assignments indicating capability and capacity to undertake the audit.

Audit Fees

The audit fees will be fixed, determined through a competitive bidding process.
