Responsibilities will include supporting the Chief of Party with program implementation, operations and administrative management, ensure that proposed activities are appropriate and acceptable to the local context and are, at a minimum, gender-responsive. He will work closely with the Infrastructure Manager so that technical activities support the operations and long-term sustainability of water infrastructure. He will also promote a learning culture for the project and will support the COP in promoting an adaptive management approach. This DCOP will be based in Juba, South Sudan.

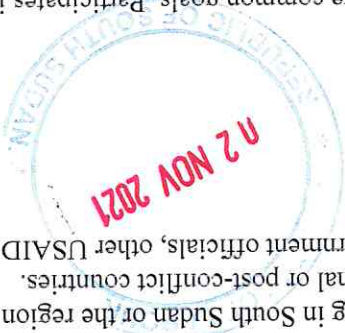
