Purpose:

Under the general guidance of the PSS/GBV Officer, the PSS facilitators will be responsible to design and management of children, adolescent and youth activities through both community and child friendly spaces working closely with children, caregivers, and other community structures.

Key Roles and Responsibilities

- Under the supervision of PSS/GBV Officer, the PSS facilitators will be responsible for mobile psychosocial activities(door to door) to children, and where needed assist in delivering parenting skills training for caregivers. The animators will transition to normal child friendly spaces (CFS) once COVID 19 situation improves and appropriate guidelines provided by the Ministry of Health.
- Participate in supporting volunteers in the organization of psychosocial activities for children and caregivers
- Plan and design psychosocial creative arts and sessions with individual children and group at the household level.
- Where possible observing COVID 19 guidelines provided by MOH deliver life skills activity packages/training for adolescents
- Identify children requiring case management and ensure safe referral to the case management team with the department
- Daily collect data on the activities organized and ensure that all the relevant forms are daily filled
- Participate in weekly reporting and planning meetings to ensure adherence to standards of care, quality PSS and case management, and reporting requirements are followed
- Work in close collaboration with the PSS Officer, case workers and other child protection programme staff
- Provide community based psychosocial counseling to children who experience violence, abuse and exploitation including child survivors of SGBV
- Organize community/family sensitization campaigns/sessions on COVID 19,GBV and child protection issues.





- Raise any concern or challenge to the PSS Officer/designate
- Work in compliance with and respect of the principles of humanitarian protection and confidentiality
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the supervisor

Qualifications and experience

- Diploma/certificate in Psychology, counseling, social sciences, social work, development studies and education from a recognized university/institution.
- At least two years' experience working with an NGO in a similar position.
- Training on child protection, GBV and psychosocial support.
- Have a genuine interest and willingness to work with children.
- Demonstrate cultural, gender, religious, nationality and age sensitivity
- Great team player, excellent communication skills, maintains good working relationships and ability to work under minimum supervision.
- Have attractive qualities relevant for working with children including warmth, welcoming and respectful attitude, understanding, non-judgmental and honest.
- Exercise self-control and self-respect
- Ability to work in hard-to-reach areas
- Fluency in oral and written English, local and Arabic languages
- Commitment to CMMB's Child Protection Policy.
