Introduction

HealthNet TPO is a global aid agency with roots in The Netherlands that has been working on restoring and strengthening health care systems in areas disrupted by war or disaster for the last 25 years. We build healthy communities with people at the bottom end of globalization. Our mission is to implement welfare and health initiatives that lead to improved health, wellbeing and social inclusion. With a health care research background, HealthNet TPO found that improving health in extremely fragile situations requires a social component in the public health approach. We developed a procedure to identify local stakeholders or agencies and existing resources in fragile populations, and to engage the whole community in a process of identifying local problems and needs. These 'local change agents' start a community dynamic that reunites people, strengthens social bonds and restores healing relationships.

Purpose of the Job

The Medical Officer will be part of HealthNet TPO team in South Sudan and he/she will be responsible for provision of CEMONC services and other Medical and surgical services in Raja hospital and will be in charge of ensuring quality of secondary health services in accordance to the Prescribed National South Sudan MOH guidelines for the Hospitals. The Medical Officer will work under the supervision of the Hospital Manager / Gynaecologist and obstetrician for Raja Hospital. He/she will be based in Raja.

Key roles and responsibilities

1. Daily comprehensive ward rounds in Maternity, Neonatal, Medical and Surgical Units with proper follow up of cases and documentation of patient's forms and registers.
2. Ensure daily administration of all CEmONC signals functions in maternity
3. Perform all emergency obstetric and gynecological procedures and record capture in HMIS tool
4. Perform/participate in all obstetrics/gynecological and surgical procedures that include, but not limited to C/S, laparotomy for ectopic pregnancy, management abortion complications, with proper



documentation, appendectomy, hernia and hernia repair & perform others surgical and obstetric emergencies.

5. Daily mentorship of clinical officers and midwives/nurses on CEmONC topics and medico-surgical wards and list of topics/attendee recorded and shared with Hospital Coordinator
6. Attend to all ANC sessions and ensure ANC register is well filled correctly
7. Attend to daily OPD consultations and make sure all OPD cases are register in the GOPD register
8. Attend 24 hours' emergency calls for all maternal and neonatal, Surgical and medical cases
9. Ensure referral of patients and mothers to next health level follows standard guideline and record for referral available for monthly reporting
10. Attend and participate in all weekly CMEs and be responsible for organizing weekly CME/Ground rounds.
11. Participate in all partners training and conduct trainings that are relevant to CEmONC services including daily on job training for all junior staff in the wards-
12. Ensure all the routine screening for ANC mothers are done and documented
13. Ensured that all HMIS data for Maternity, ANC, Neonatal units, medical and surgical wards are collected and ready for monthly submission to county Health Department M&E.
14. Do counseling and administration of family planning methods according to South Sudan guidelines and protocol.
15. Attend all clinical management meetings and hospital advisory board meetings
16. Undertakes any other responsibility assigned by the supervisor.

Qualifications required

1. Bachelors in Medicine & Surgery from a recognized University with atleast three years of clinical experience in a busy setting.
2. Ability to develop implementation plans for project activities
3. A good understanding and experience of working with County Health Officials, State Ministry Officials, Donors and UN agencies and the health system in South Sudan.
4. Previous experience of working in South Sudan and Ability to work in areas of limited resources.
5. Excellent report writing and reporting skills and people skills
