GIZ's coordination office has been in the capital, Juba, since 2010.

The GIZ Coordination Office Juba is urgently seeking a qualified candidate to fill the vacant position of Monitoring & Evaluation Specialist for its Governance Bundle Projects (Rural Governance in South Sudan, Local Governance and promotion of peaceful co-existence in South Sudan and SGBV).

Scope of the Position:

Generally, the Monitoring & Evaluation Specialist in consultation with the line manager collect, prepare and provide relevant data and support the programs and projects in their strategic orientation and operational planning.

Your Tasks

- Support to the technical team in the development and implementation of an efficient conflict-, context- and gendersensitive results-based monitoring system;
- Support the project including regular reporting to GIZ and commissioning party (BMZ), on activities, outputs, impacts, and external risks, including quality assurance of data sets and data analysis;
- Support the technical team and partner organizations in establishing a custom-fit M&E system based on GIZ criteria:
- Support the technical team and partner organizations in collecting data and relevant information for ongoing evaluation of project activities, results, impacts and assessment of external risks:

- Conduct regular visits to the project sites and partners to check on progress of data collection and to advice on problem
- Liaise with project colleagues and external partners and coordinate knowledge transfer between the GIZ offices in South Sudan and
- Capacity building of program/project staff to ensure M&E tools are fully understood and used appropriately;
- Organize regular program/project reviews in consultation with the program staff to ensure implementations are on track.

- Regularly compile information and develop information material for internal and external communication purposes

- Bachelor's degree in political, economic or social sciences, peace and conflict studies or equivalent;
