To provide quality HIV testing and Counseling Services (HTS) to every client according to the National HTS Guideline

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Ensures that all client get pre- test information and informed consent before HIV testing
2. Ensure all the test kits and other supplies are available and has valid expiry dates before testing.
3. Create relationship and provide conducive environment to clients
4. Explain confidentiality
5. Review a client's risk assessment and risk reduction Plan
6. Ensure client understands HIV rapid test procedures and the meaning of test result.
7. Help client think about possible reactions to the test result and whom to inform
8. Provide posttest counseling to every clients according to the national guideline
9. Provide appropriate coping information for clients who are tested HIV positive.
10. Provide preventive information package for clients who are tested HIV negative.
11. Help clients who are tested HIV positive to join HIV support group.
12. Explore the issue of disclosure with clients and, where appropriate, assist them in disclosing their status to relevant parties
13. Help clients develop a supportive and nurturing environment, experience self-sufficiency, and gain a sense of control over their health in general.
14. Linkage to care and treatment
15. Collaborate with ART Nurses to ensure all HIV positive patients are linked to HIV care and treatment
16. Escort HIV positive clients to the ART Clinic for treatment
17. Record the client's unique ART number from the feedback form into the respective HTS Register.
18. Work together with HTS focal person to ensure HTS tools are available and updated accordingly all the time

EDUCATION

- At least Diploma in social sciences including social work, or a closely related field with 2-3 year of related experience preferred.
- Basic computer skill is required.

Desirable Qualification

- Requires the ability and commitment to respect and support inclusiveness and diversity individuals of different backgrounds, cultures, races, ages, sexual orientations, gender identities or expressions, experiences, opinions, etc.
- Requires individual demonstration of commitment to the JTH behaviors and service impacts and modeling them in the organization.
