Objectives and Scope

Within the framework of UNESCO's Education for Health and Wellbeing Strategy and the O3 Programme (Our Rights, Our Lives, Our Future), UNESCO is inviting registered community radio stations operating in **South Sudan** to partner in developing content, organizing, and broadcasting Community Live Events on adolescent health and wellbeing.

Expected Procurement Components

The objective of this future procurement tender is to identify and engage qualified Community radio stations to partner in developing content, organizing, and broadcasting Community Live Events on adolescent health and wellbeing as described in the accompanying document.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a legally registered community radio station operating within the country
- Demonstrated ability to produce and broadcast at least three programmes within a six-month timeframe
- Able to provide evidence of audience reach (listenership data, coverage maps, or listener feedback mechanisms)
- Prior experience hosting programmes that address health, gender, or youth wellbeing issues

Special Procurement Conditions and Additional Information:

To be considered, interested entities are invited to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) containing the following:

- Brief company profile outlining the organization's background, number of employees, annual turnover, and years of operation
- At least three references from comparable assignments demonstrating the organization's relevant experience and qualifications for participation in this prospective solicitation process.
- Technical proposal describing the proposed methodology, work plan and composition of the project team
- Financial proposal providing comprehensive breakdown of all associated costs.
- Company profile together with a valid Tax Registration Certificate.
- Curriculum vitae of key personnel.
- Contact information, including the organization's full name, physical and postal address, country of registration, telephone number, email address, website, and designated contact person.

The Expression of Interest, together with all required supporting documentation, must be submitted to UNESCO no later than **July 29, 2026, 11:59 PM (Juba Time)**, via the email address provided below.
