- Full legal name and address of applying organization
- Copy of valid legal registration in the country
- Membership in the national Chamber of Commerce (if available)
- Reference from other partners will be desirable
- Sex and age of the CEO/ Director/ Head of the business entity
- Sex and age disaggregated number of women and men employed in the business
- Type of services offered (please list them all)

Along with the above-mentioned documents, please share a note of not more than two pages on how your company is trying to integrate gender responsiveness into your business activities. How does doing business with you positively impact gender equality?



Upon receipt of the above information from prospective organizations, UNFPA will evaluate and preassess applicants.
