Price and currency policy:

The prices shall be free of VAT and other public charges. Which you may thought of, the prices shall be quoted in United State Dollars (USD). The quoted price shall be valid for 30 days from date of closure of submission of quotes.

Submission of quotations:

Quotation shall only be submitted in hard copy to the following address: ADA Office, UNMISS Road Opposite MEDAIR office, Tongpiny.

Registration for submission:

Please make sure, you register your hand delivered quotation with the procurement department and drop it in the Tender box yourself.

Request for clarifications:

Any request for clarification must be made in writing through the email: johnyiek.ada@gmail.com this enquires must be send within **48 hours** before the tender closing date.

Dateline for the submission of the quotes:

The dateline for the submission of the quotes will be strictly on **19 April to 25 April 2022 at 4:00 PM**

Evaluation of quotes and award of supply contract:

The quotes will be evaluated and the supply contract must be awarded based South Sudan legal Register Documents and price, delivery terms, brand, quality assurances and any other factor which the procurement committee shall deem necessary. **Notification of the results:**

Only the successful bidder will be notified, and if you do not receive an order in writing from ADA within two weeks after the expiry of the dateline, consider your bid unsuccessful.

Language of the bid:

The language to be used when applying shall be English only.

Terms of payment procedures:

Payment shall be made within a maximum of **30** working days after the completion of delivery of the materials subject to appropriate deduction for incomplete deliveries upon the presentation of commercial invoice. Payment will be made by **Bank transfer** to the supplier's **Bank Account** only.
