CIDO is looking for a suitable candidate to fill the position of Mid Wife for “Health SSHF 1” Round Standard Allocation” Project 2021.


Job overview

The Midwife bears responsibility for all aspects of the maternity departments in a mobile clinic: referrals of the delivery's, prenatal consultations, and ensures the follow up of women and new-borns under the supervision of a specialized doctor

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensure that pregnant mothers receive appropriate ANC services during the first visit and ensure all their relevant data is taken and recorded to the relevant registers
- Maintain professional contact with the mothers, note their complains and report them to the relevant authorities to be addressed
- Provide care to mothers during labour recording all signs and monitoring foetus progress through partograph.

- d. Actively manage normal vaginal deliveries assessing the child at birth and summoning immediate appropriate intervention.
 - e. Identify high-risk signs like haemorrhage, eclampsia and any others during pregnancy and labour, give first line management and refer the complicated cases keeping proper records.
 - f. Manage obstetrical emergencies and refer complicated cases to the next level of health care
 - g. Identify high-risk pregnancies in time and make the necessary referrals i for appropriate specialized care.
 - h. Educate the mothers on proper child care and breast feeding practices
 - i. Identify and treat minor ailments the might be detrimental to the health of the mothers and the new born
 - j. Perform other duties as assigned

Required Professional and Technical Skills:

- Enrolled/Registered Midwife with Diploma/Certificate from a recognized institution with a confirmed post-qualification experience.
- 2-3 years of experience in hospital and/or humanitarian work is an added advantage
- Registered and with a valid practicing license
- Excellent communication skills, Strong interpersonal skills, creativity, flexibility, adaptability and empathy.
- Proven ability to work cooperatively with others in a team environment
- Must be ready to work under minimal supervision
- Confirmed track record of providing professional patient care
