Aim of the position:

The Agriculture Extension Worker will technically support AVSI Food Security and Livelihood (FSL) activities and especially the planning, organization and implementation of the targeted goals and Objectives of FSL projects, the planning and organization of Monitoring activities and technical trainings and providing on job training to the Agriculture community facilitators.

Job Description:

- Ensure that Agriculture and Food Security outputs meet project objectives and are aligned with International best practice and consider cross cutting issues such as gender and sustainability:
- Ensures selection of beneficiary households within the target areas are following the approved beneficiary selection criteria.
- Take lead during distribution of emergency livelihood kits and share the reports on weekly basis to the project manager.
- Establishment and monitor of veg/crop groups and demo plots/APFS, in coordination with the CAD, as per project requirements and continuous follow up;
- Ensure appropriate support to the field sites where the program is implemented through regular visits.
- Collaborate/facilitate in the on-job training in Extension assistants and Food Security Assistants, and support project implementation for community groups.
- Perform any other project activity that may be assigned to you by your supervisors from time to time.
- Produce reports on project activities and other reports as requested.
- Ensure correct and complete documentation is provided from activities.



- Constructively participate to project review and planning, review of progress of project objectives and targets in collaboration with supervising specialist and the team;
- Coordinate with relevant partners and stakeholders (Farmers group, County Agriculture Department, local authorities and ensure team spirit.

Work experience

- At least 2-3 years of professional experience
